Think of the names of animals, food, and places that begin with the letters in the word BLOSSOM. Write the names in the correct boxes below. One word in each column has already been done for you.

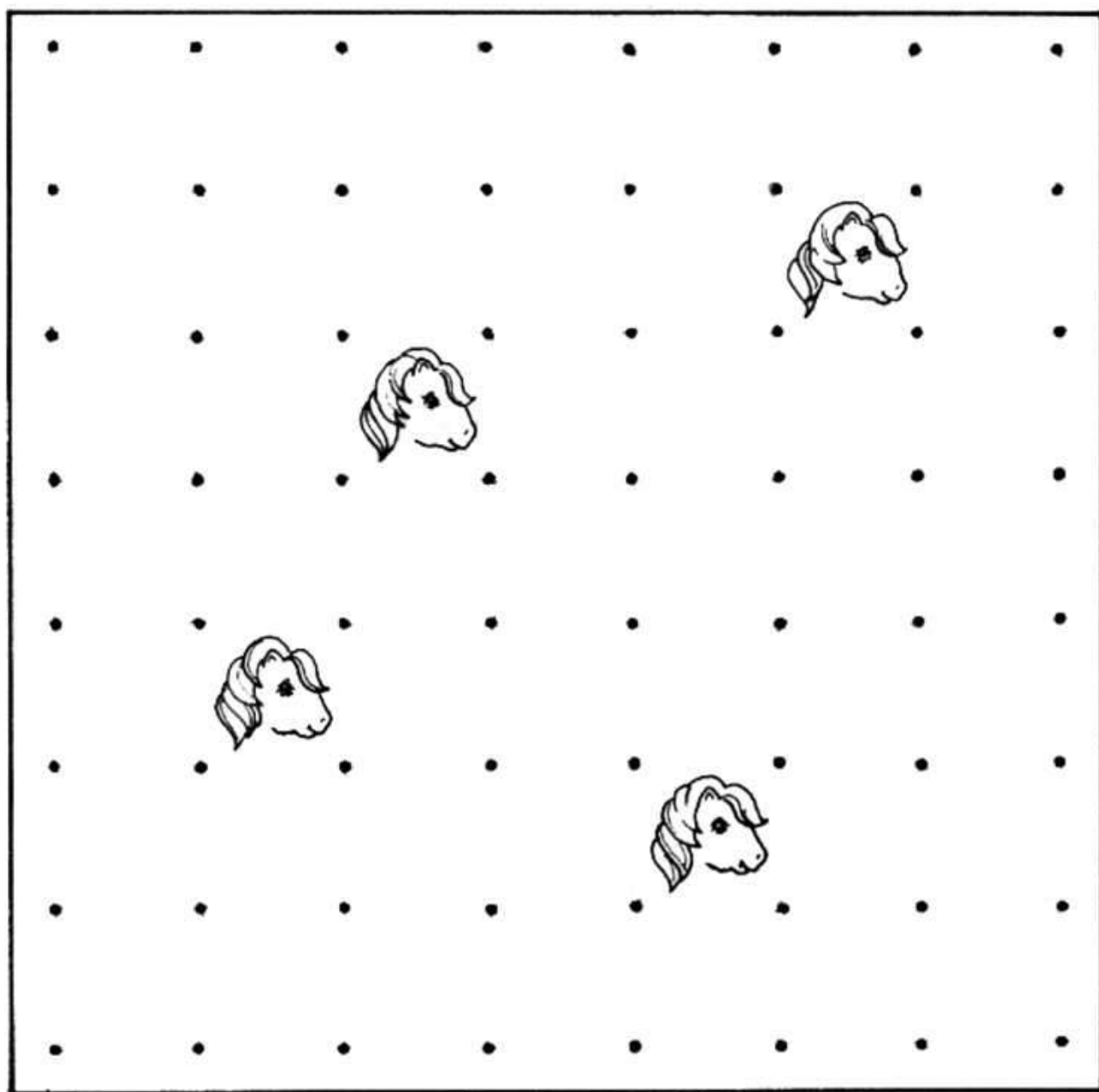

Bubbles is playing in her favorite field. Find six things in this picture that begin with the letter B. (*The answers to this and the other puzzles begin on page 46.*)



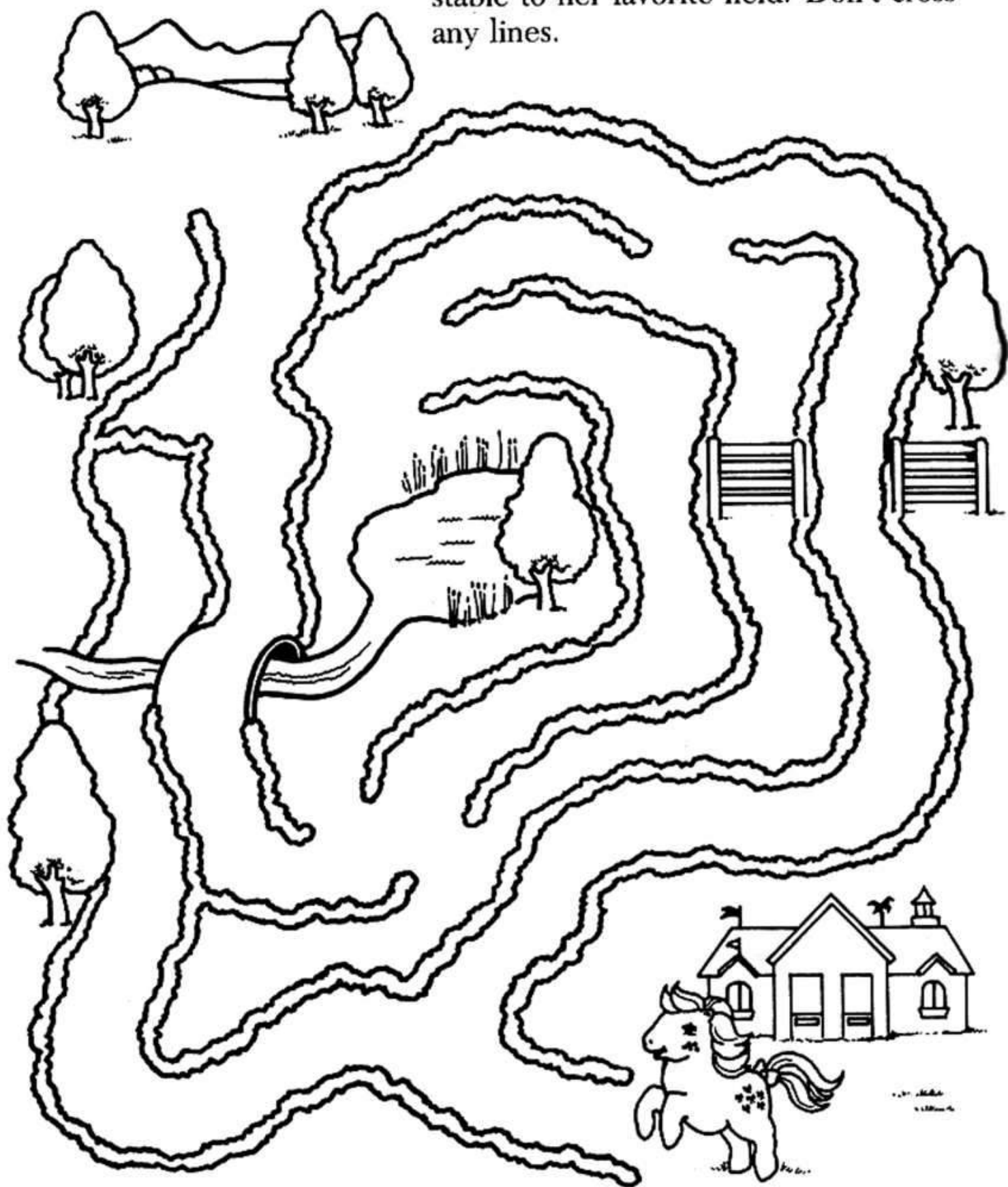

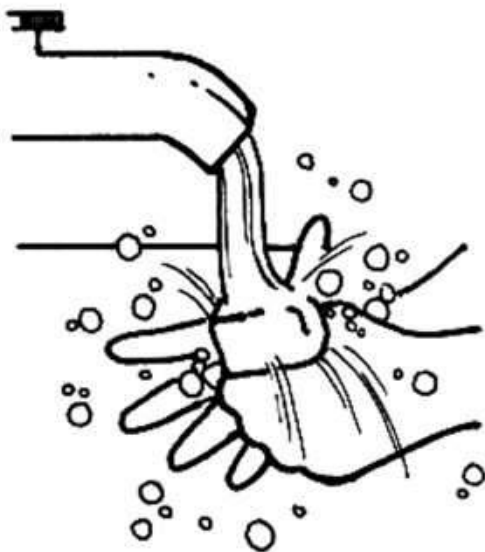


Oatmeal Candy

You will need:

$\frac{1}{2}$ cup peanut butter
 $\frac{2}{3}$ cup instant oatmeal
 $\frac{1}{4}$ cup instant dry milk
4 tablespoons honey
 $\frac{1}{4}$ cup nuts
 $\frac{1}{2}$ cup coconut
A little milk

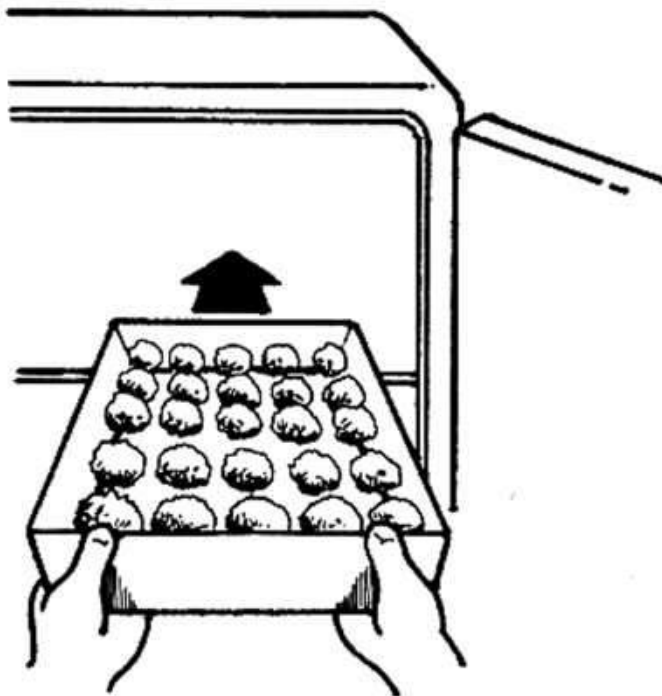
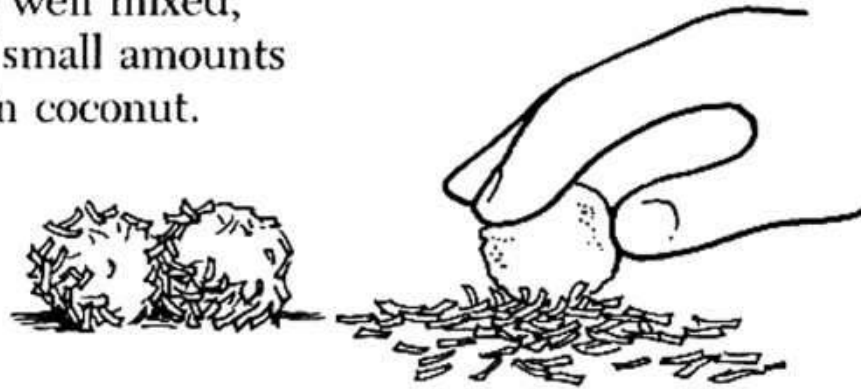


1. Wash your hands with soap and water.



2. Put the first five ingredients in a large bowl and mix together with your hands or a wooden spoon. Add the milk only if the mixture doesn't stick together.

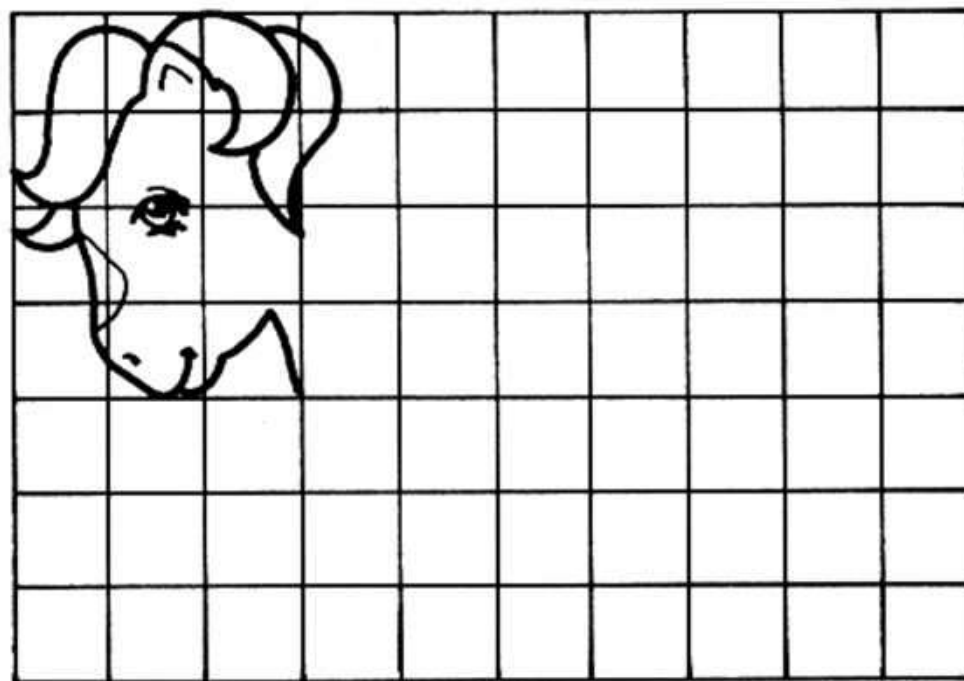
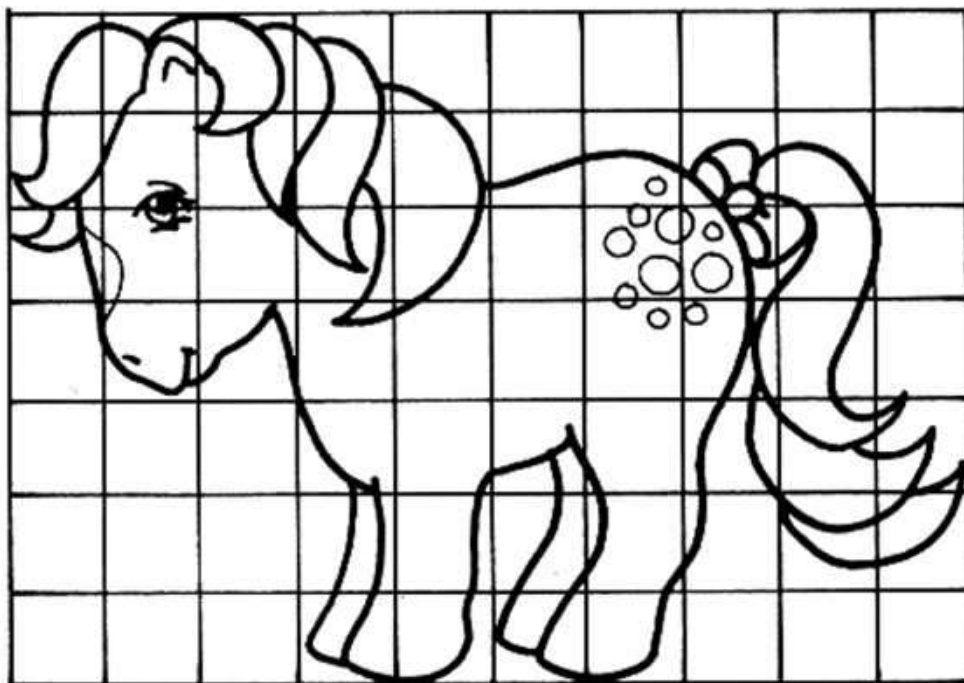
3. When well mixed, break off small amounts and roll in coconut.



4. Place in refrigerator for two hours before eating.

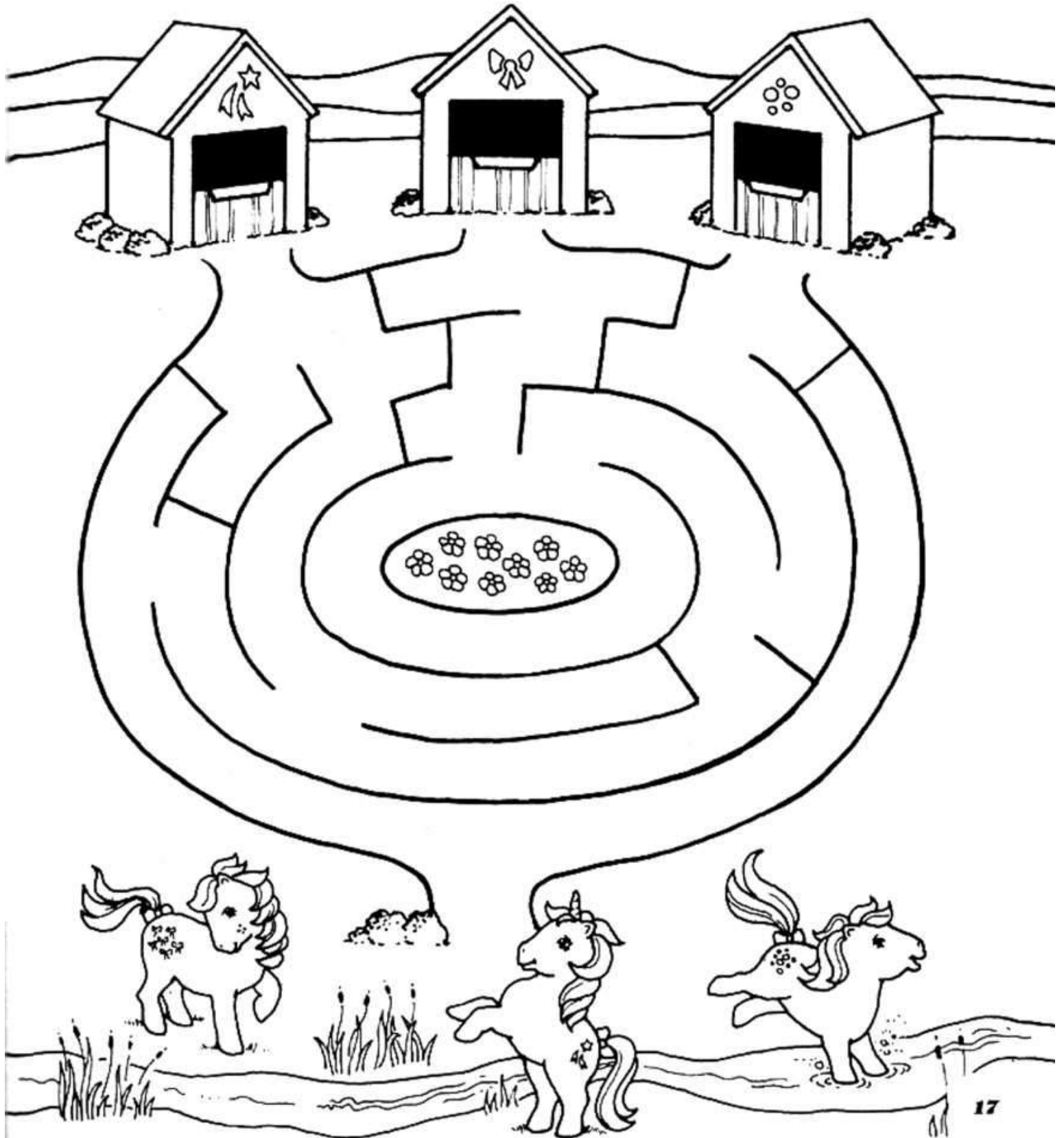
Portrait of Bubbles

Ponies on Parade

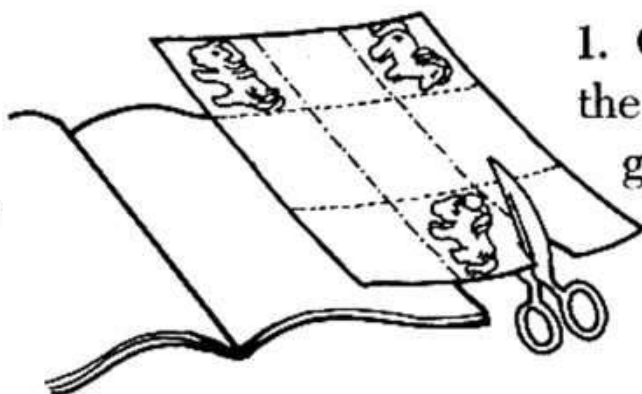
Make this Little Pony decoration for your room.

1. Cut page 19 from the book. (Ask a grownup to help you with the scissors.)

2. Cut the page into three strips where marked.

3. Fold each strip along the dotted line (make one strip at a time).



4. Cut out the design along the heavy black lines. Be careful not to cut along the folded edges.



5. Unfold the strip of paper and you will find a row of ponies.

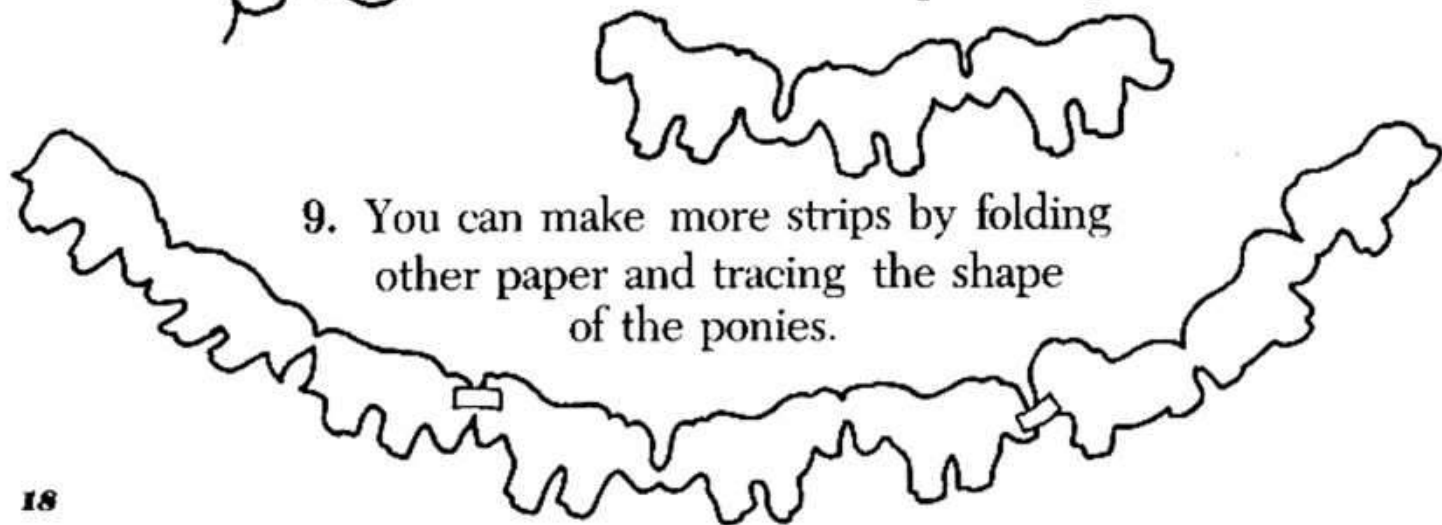
6. Color the ponies. Don't forget to draw in their faces.



7. Now cut the other strips along the heavy black lines and make more ponies.

8. When you have colored the three strips, tape them together with the cellophane tape.

9. You can make more strips by folding other paper and tracing the shape of the ponies.





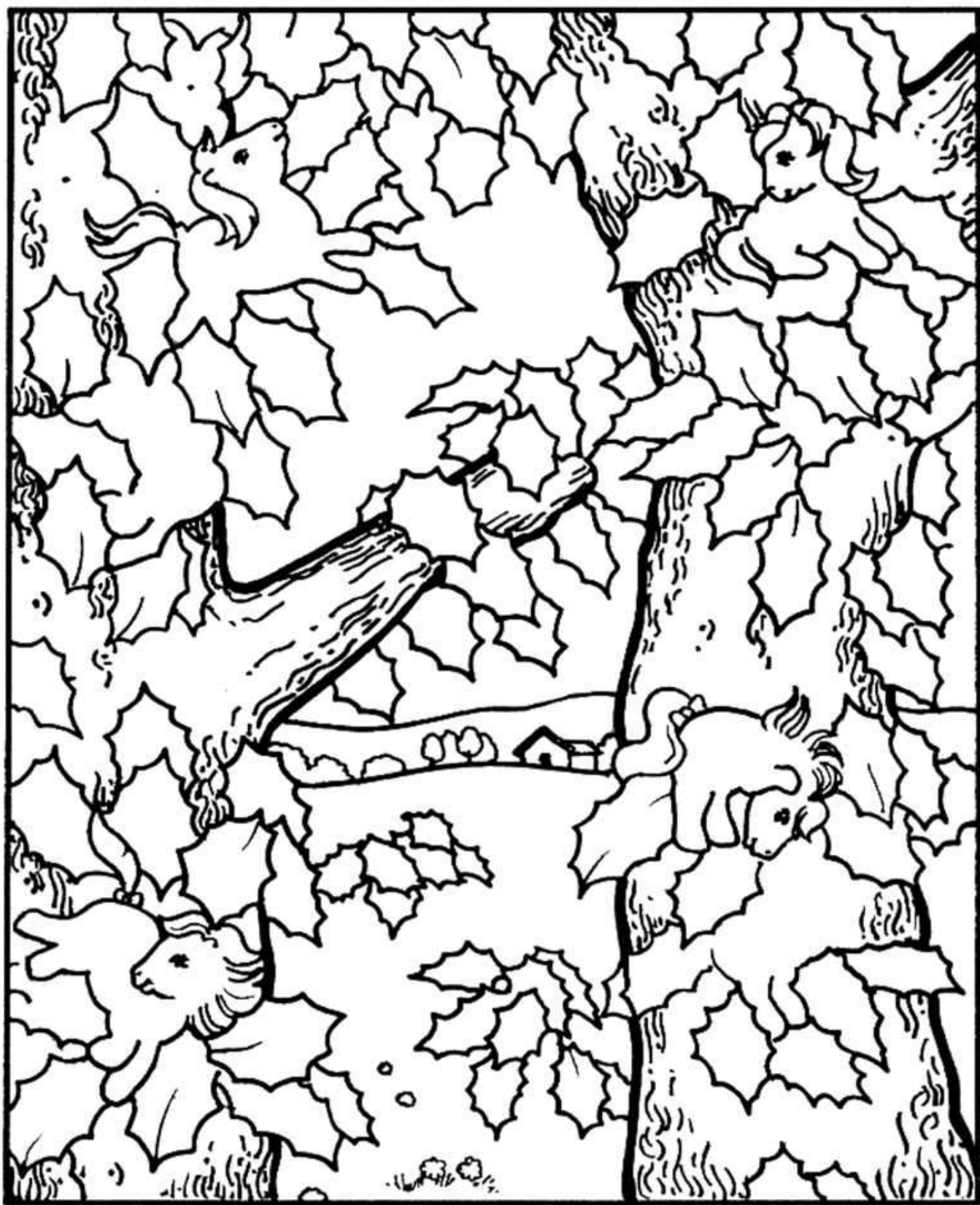

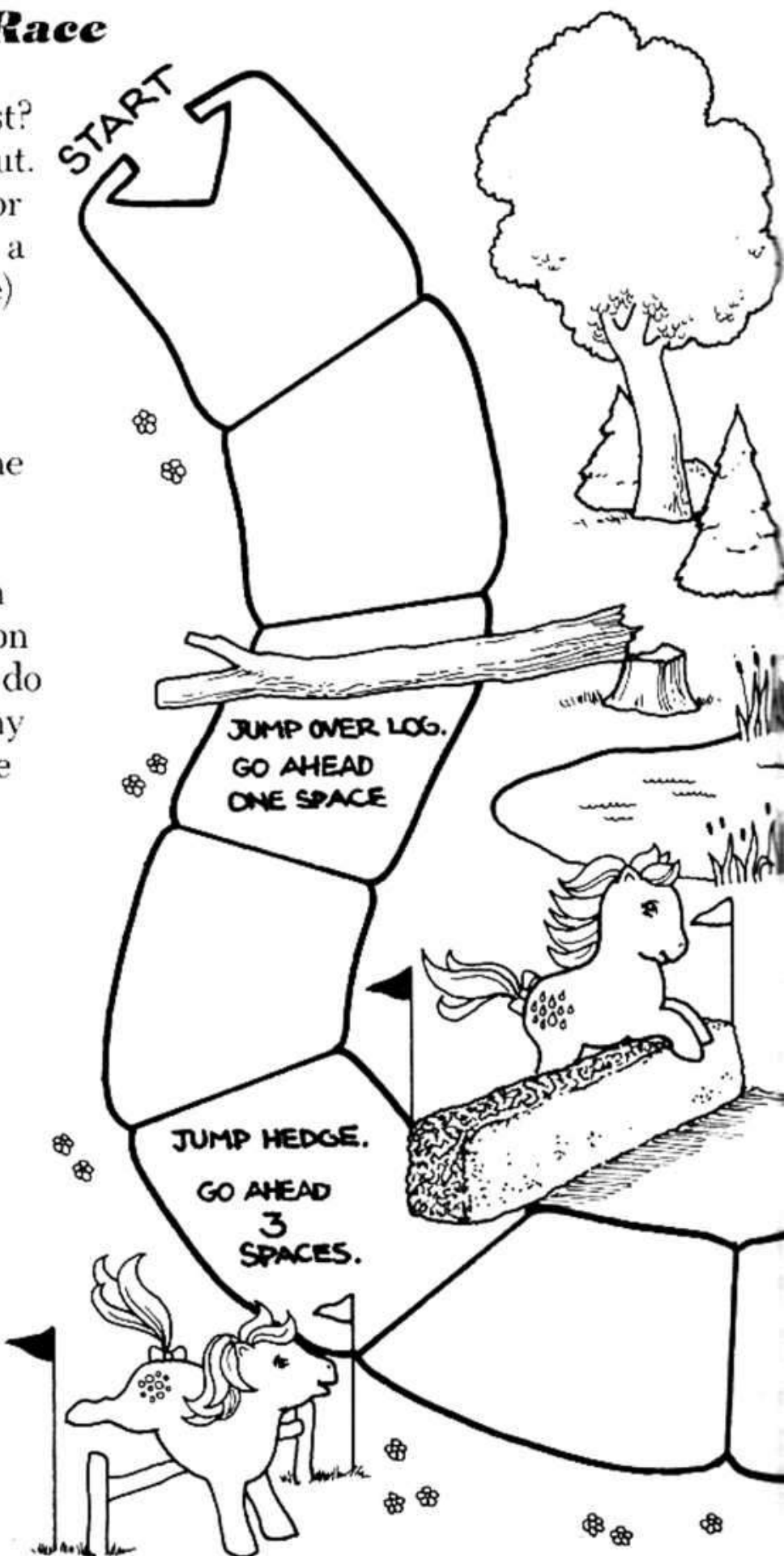


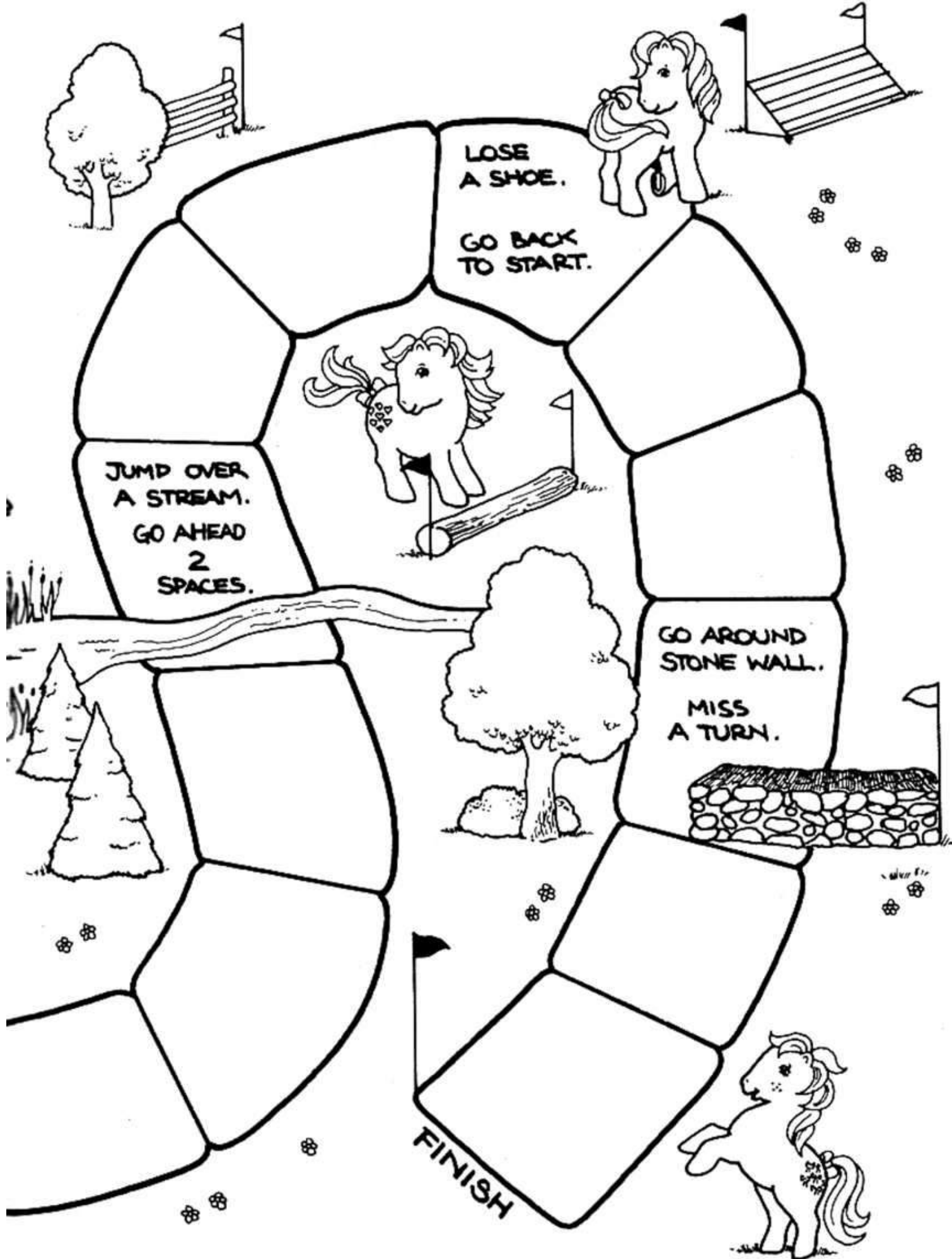
Cross-Country Race

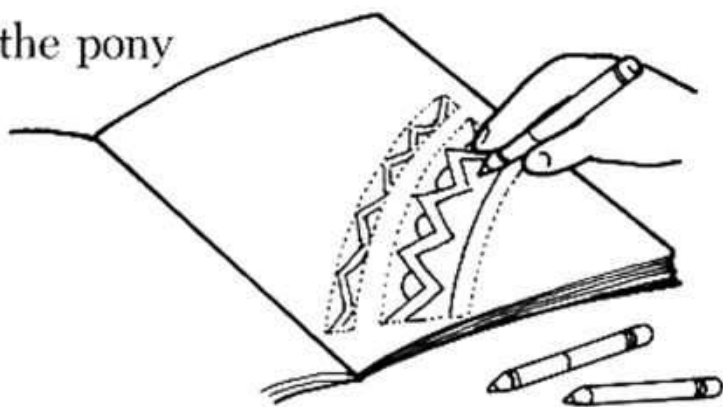
An 8-ounce plastic foam cup

Glue

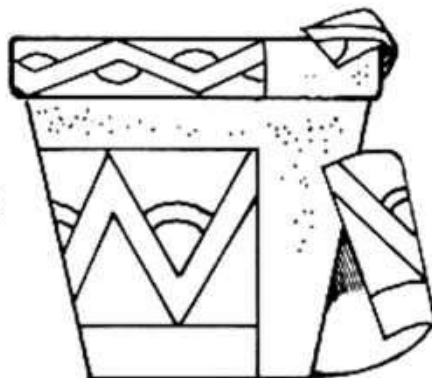

1. Color the bands for the pony stand and the hoop.

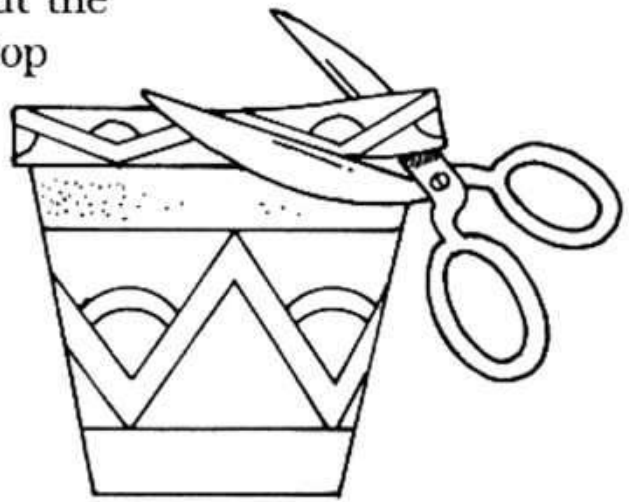


2. Cut the page from the book and cut out the colored bands. (Ask a grownup to help you with the scissors.)

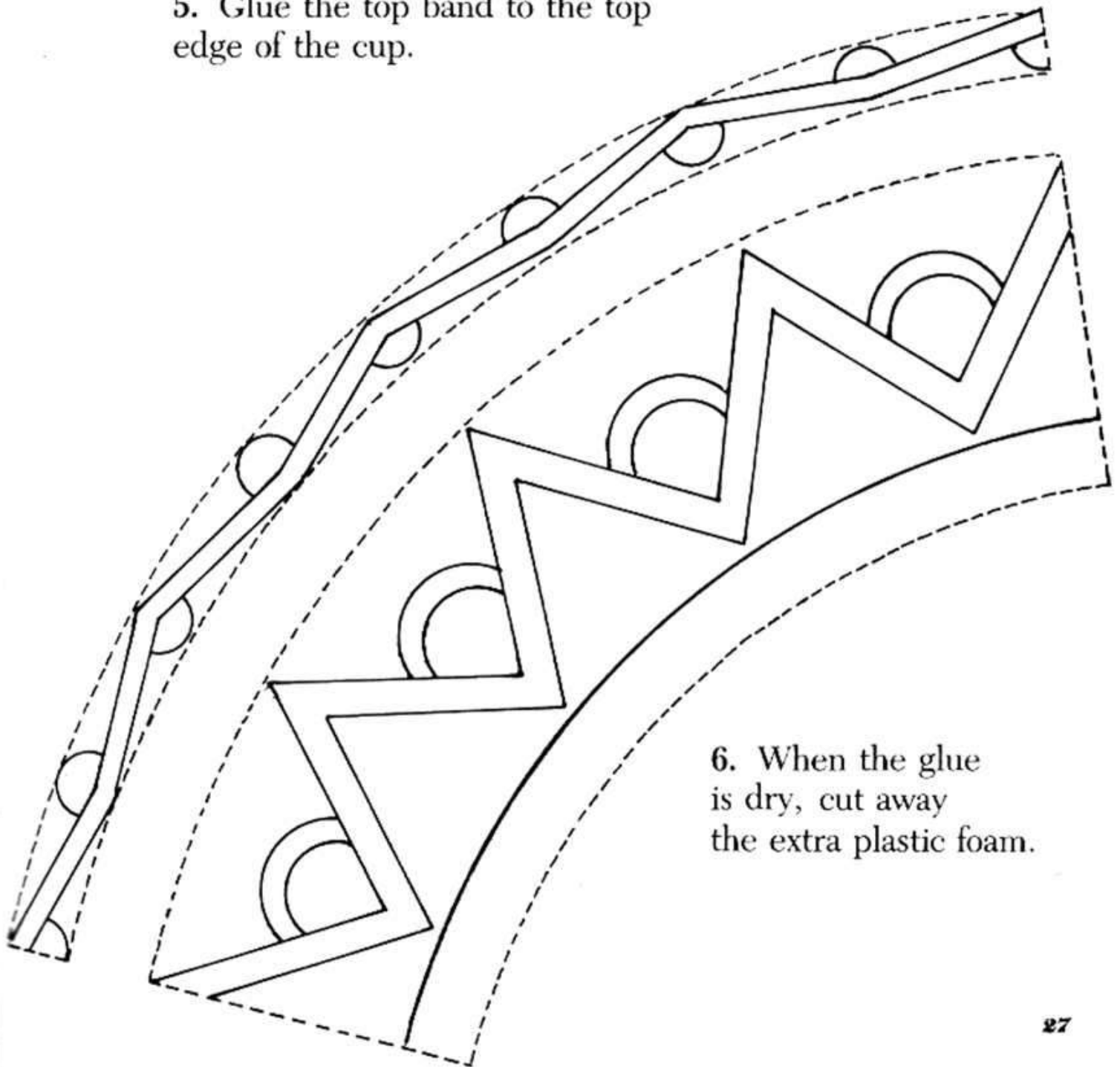
3. Glue the bottom band to the cup.



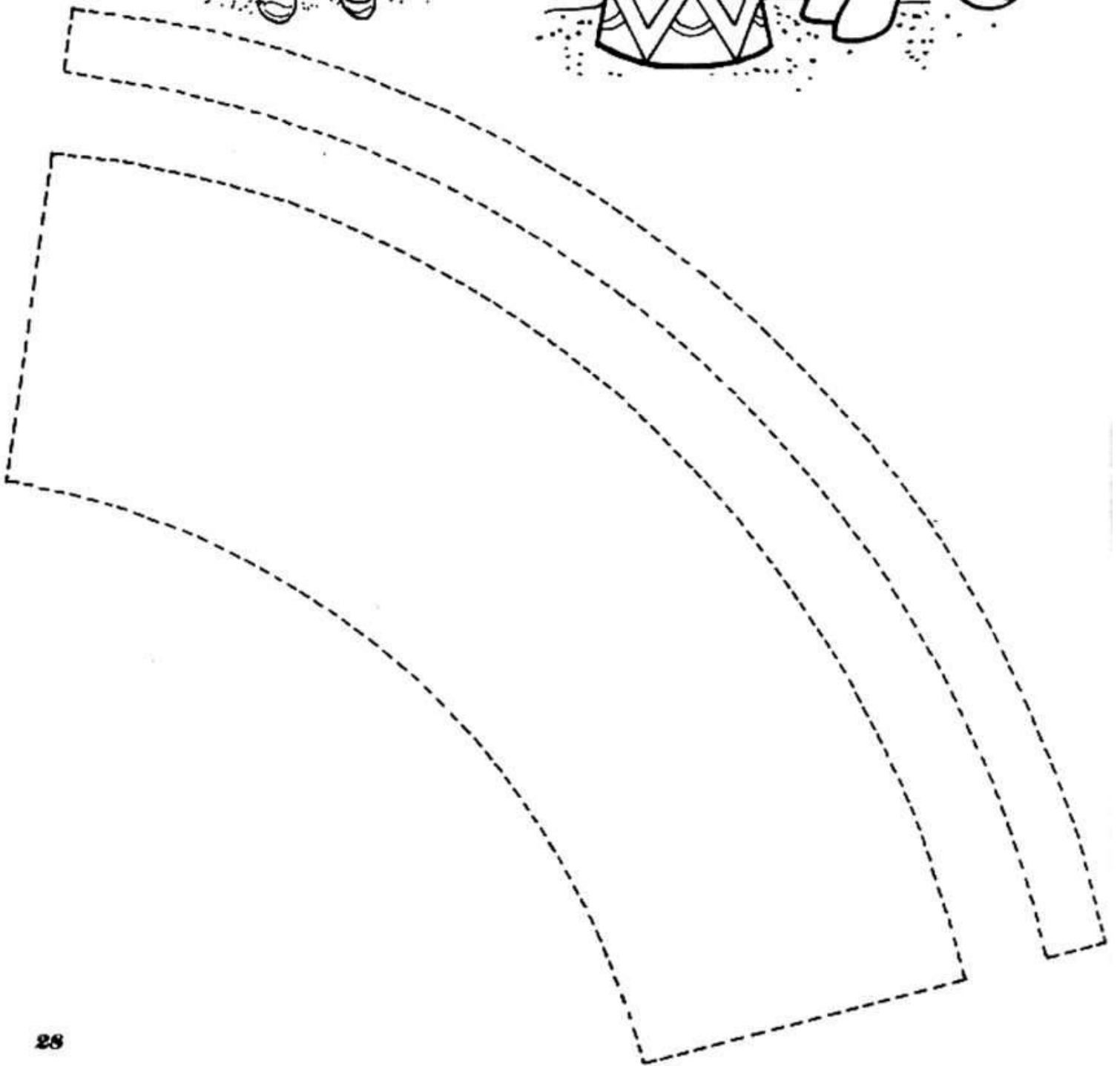
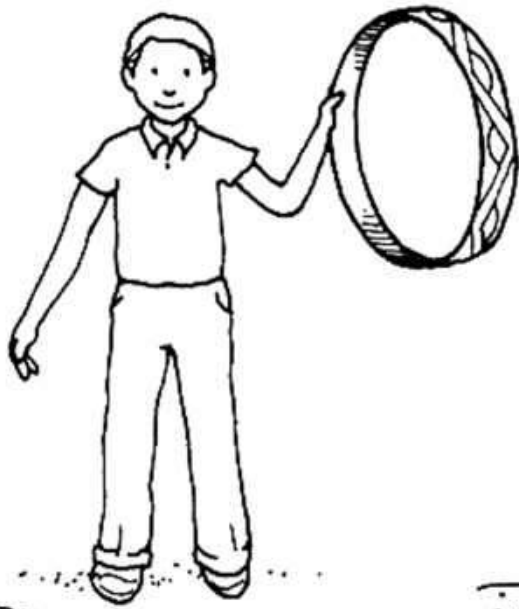
4. When the glue is dry, cut the plastic foam cup along the top edge of the band.



5. Glue the top band to the top edge of the cup.

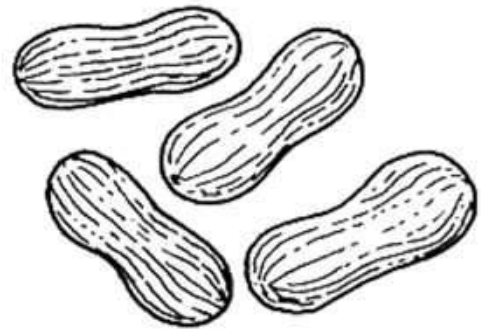
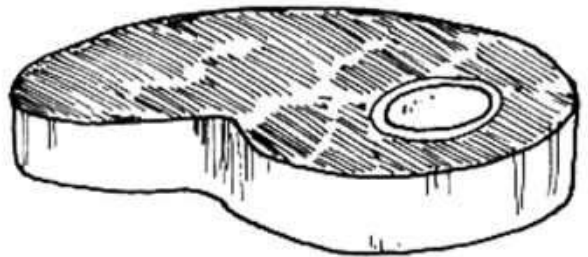
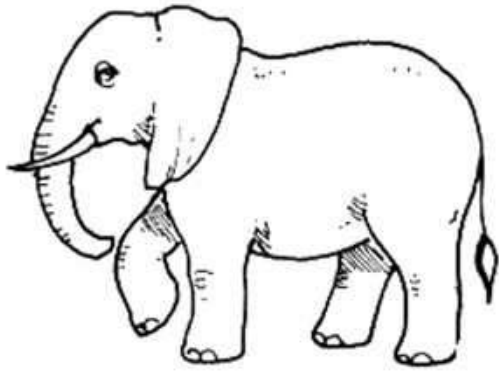


6. When the glue is dry, cut away the extra plastic foam.



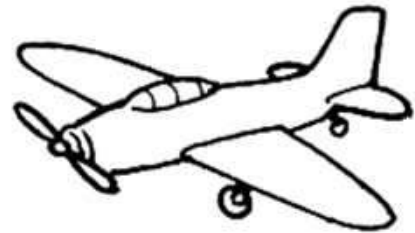
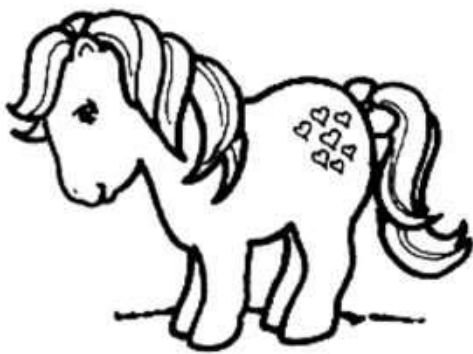
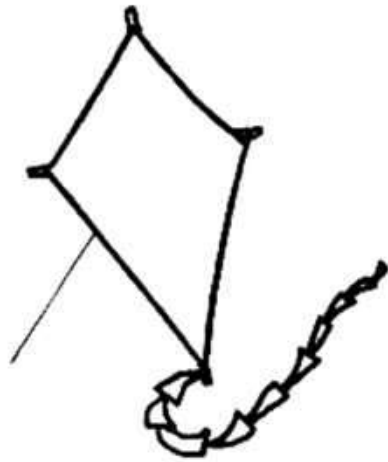
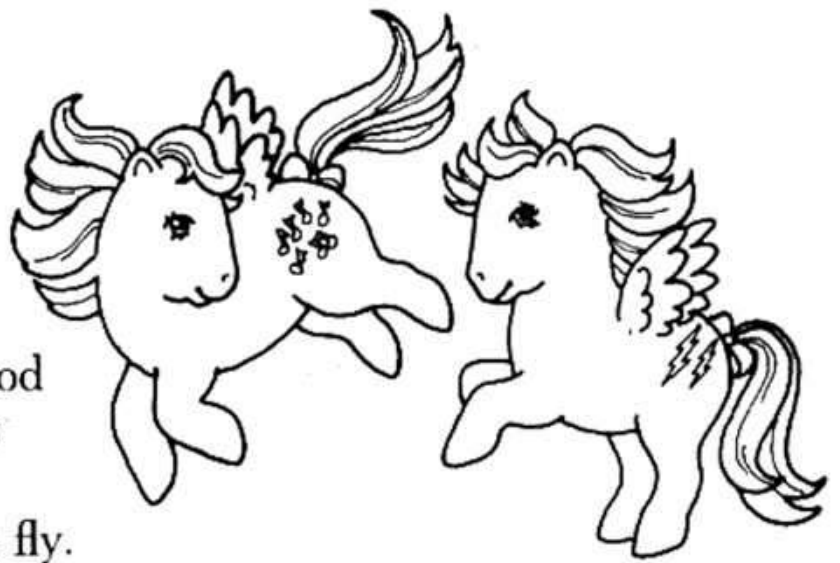

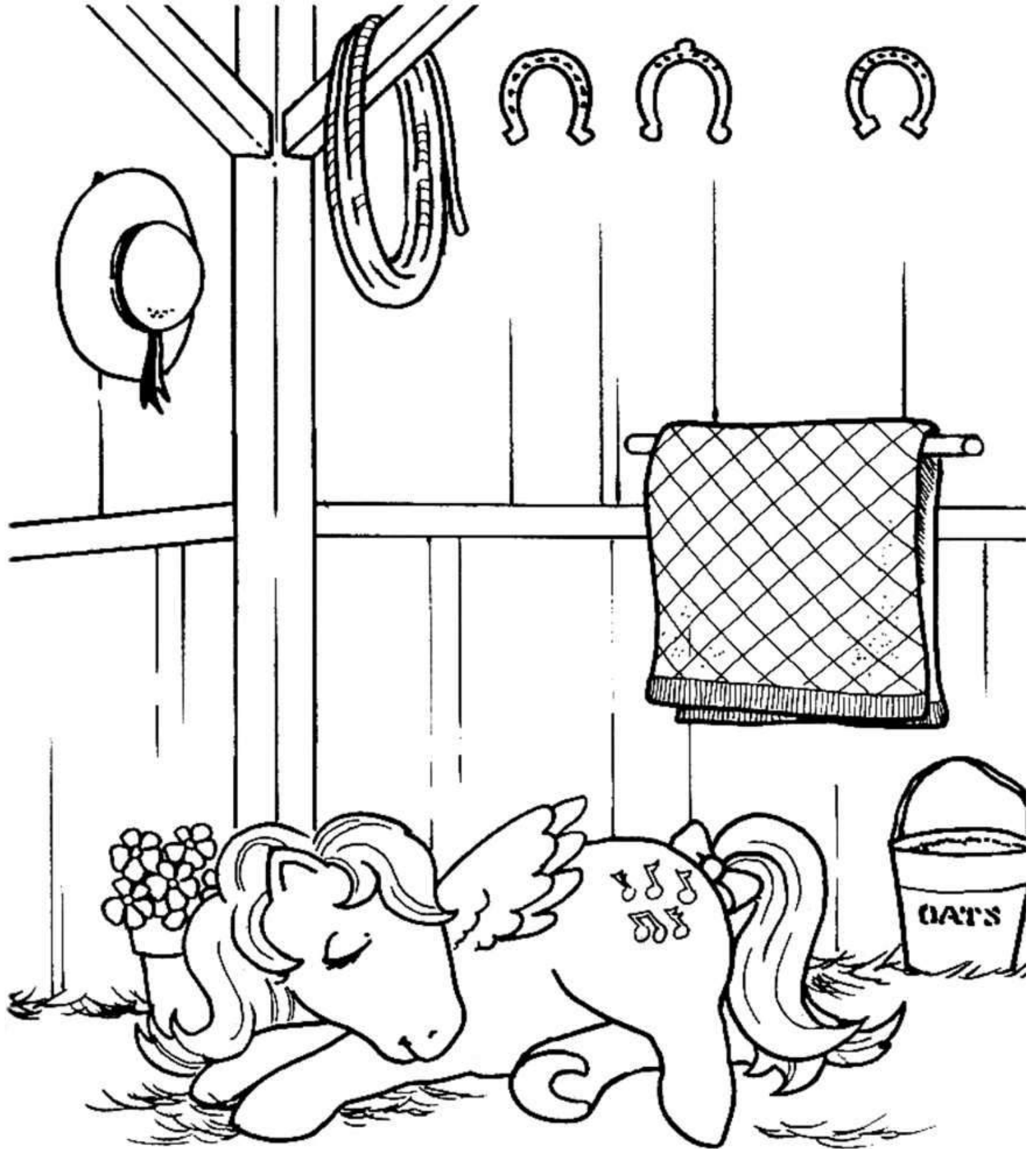

Flying High

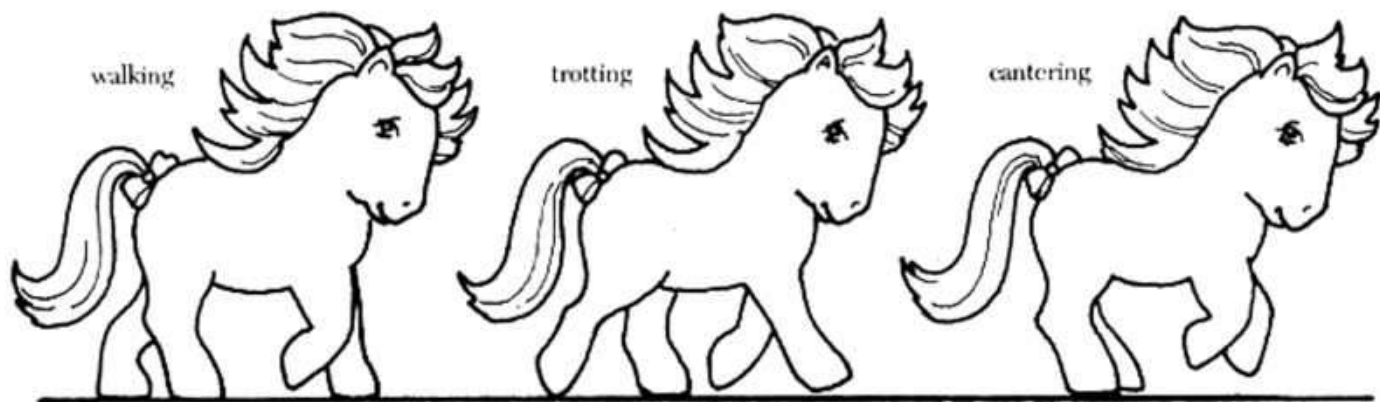
Medley and Firefly are good flyers. Lots of other things can fly too. Draw a circle around the things that can fly.





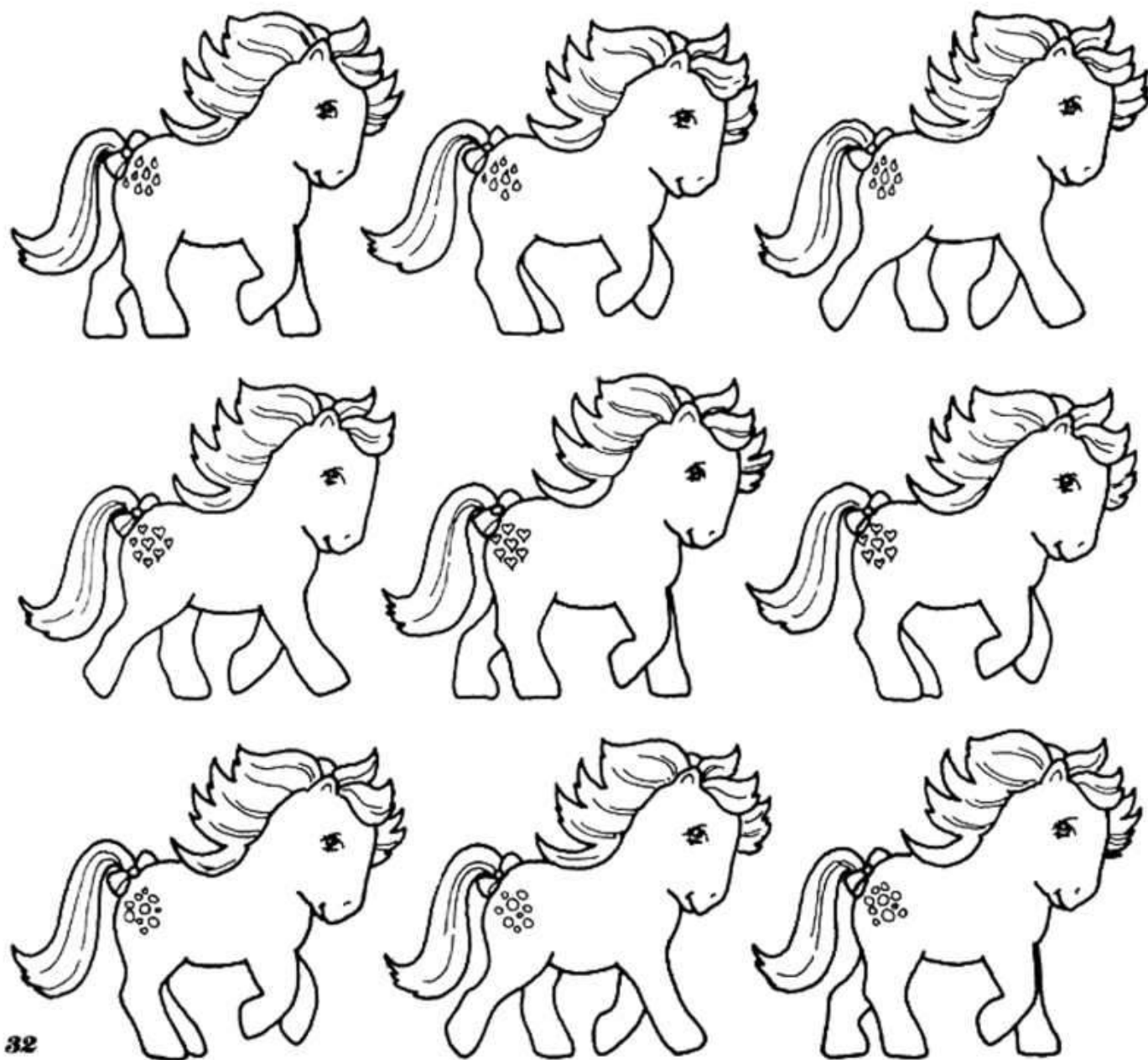
A Good Rest

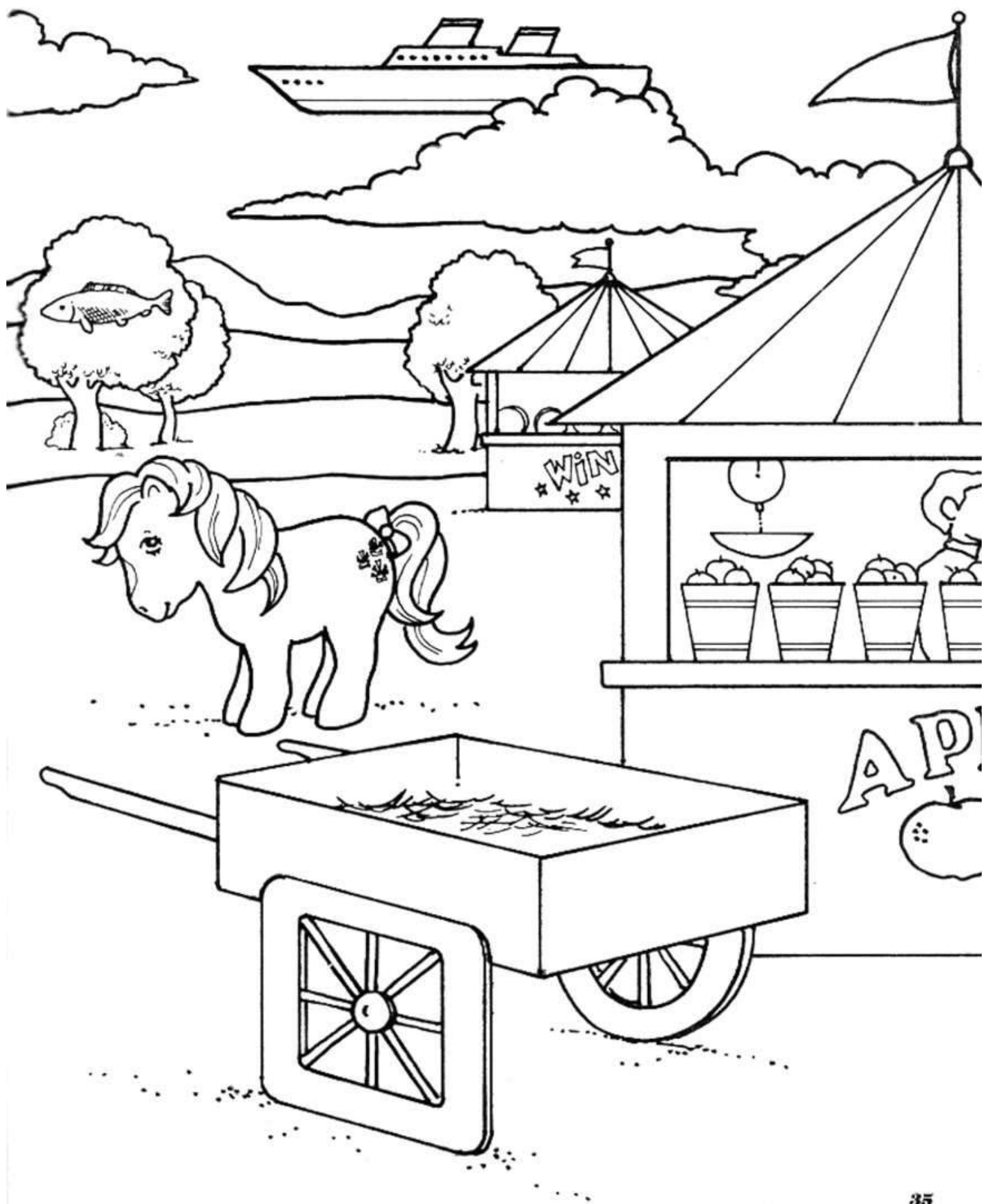

A piece of fabric $4\frac{1}{2}$ inches by 2 inches

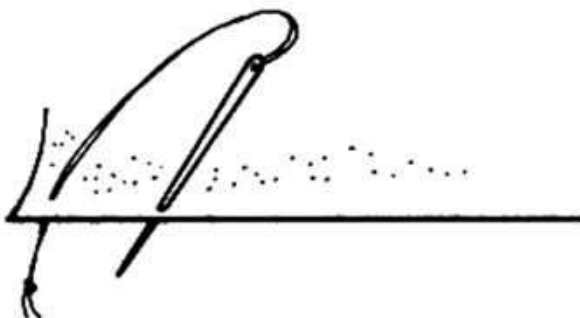
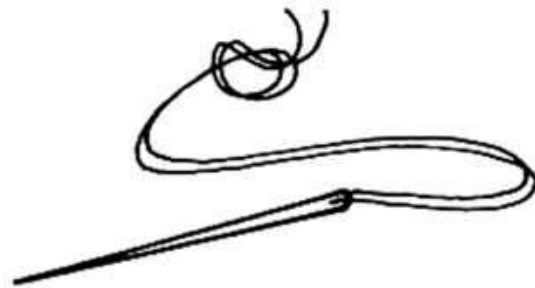
2 pieces of ribbon, each $\frac{1}{4}$ inch wide and 7 inches long

A needle

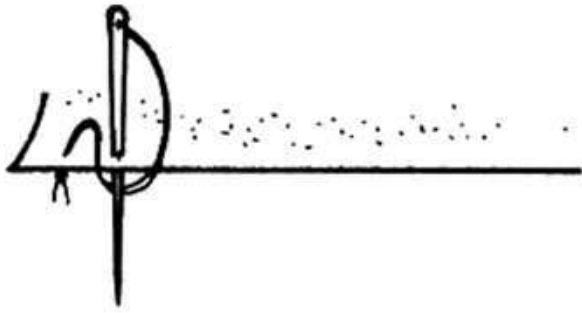
Brightly colored embroidery thread

Scissors

1. Thread the needle with a piece of embroidery thread. Make a knot in the thread. (Ask a grownup to help you.)

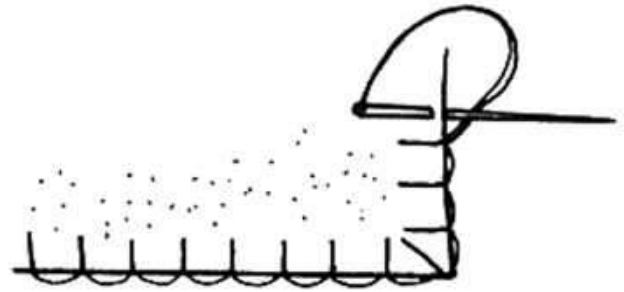


2. Work from left to right. With the edge of the fabric and the needle pointed toward you, push the needle into the fabric from the wrong side to the right side.



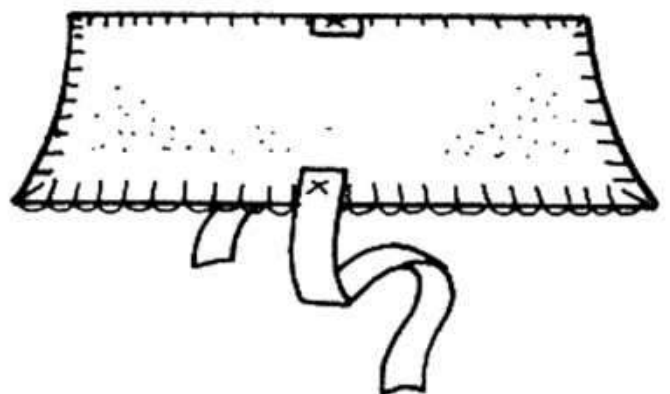
3. To make a stitch, insert the needle on the right side of the fabric and bring it out at the edge, keeping the thread under the front of the needle. As you pull the needle over the thread, you will make a stitch along the edge of the fabric. Don't pull the thread tight. The stitch must lie flat.

4. Work blanket stitch all the way around your fabric. Make the last stitch by inserting the needle into the same place you started your first stitch.



5. To finish off your thread: With the wrong side of your work facing you, push the needle through two or three stitches and backstitch over them. Ask a grownup to help you cut off the extra thread.

6. Stitch a ribbon to the middle of each of the longer sides of the blanket.



Now you have a beautiful blanket for your Little Pony!

A Winner's Wreath

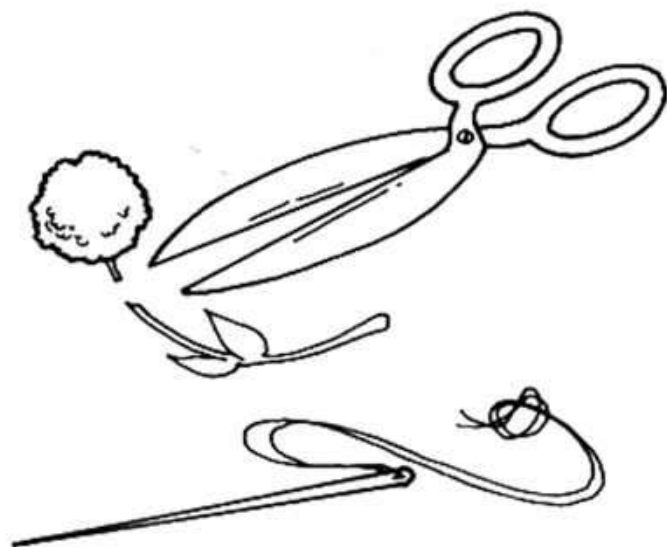
Your Little Pony will be a winner in this wreath!

as you want your wreath

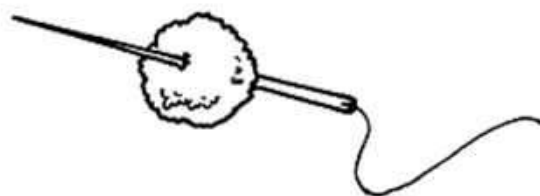
Scissors



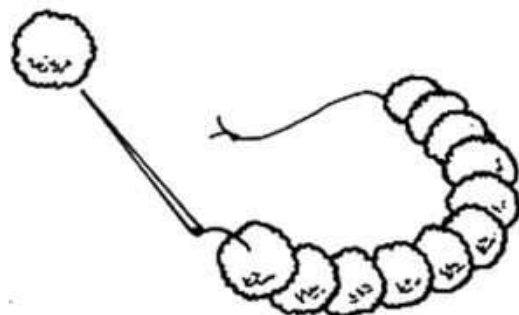
1. Cut the stems very short.

the center of each flower.



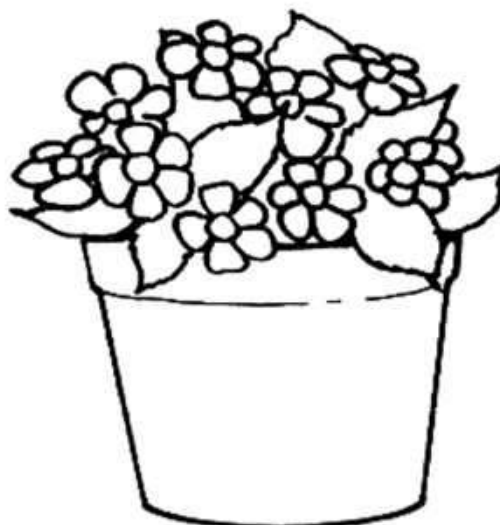
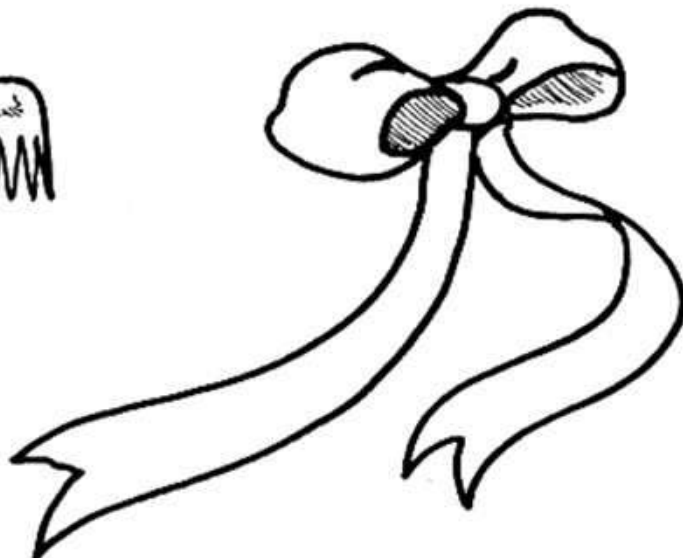
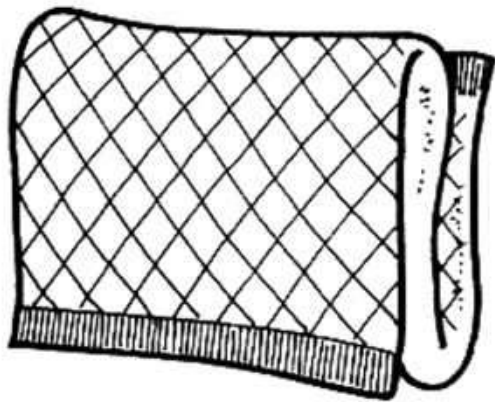

your wreath together.

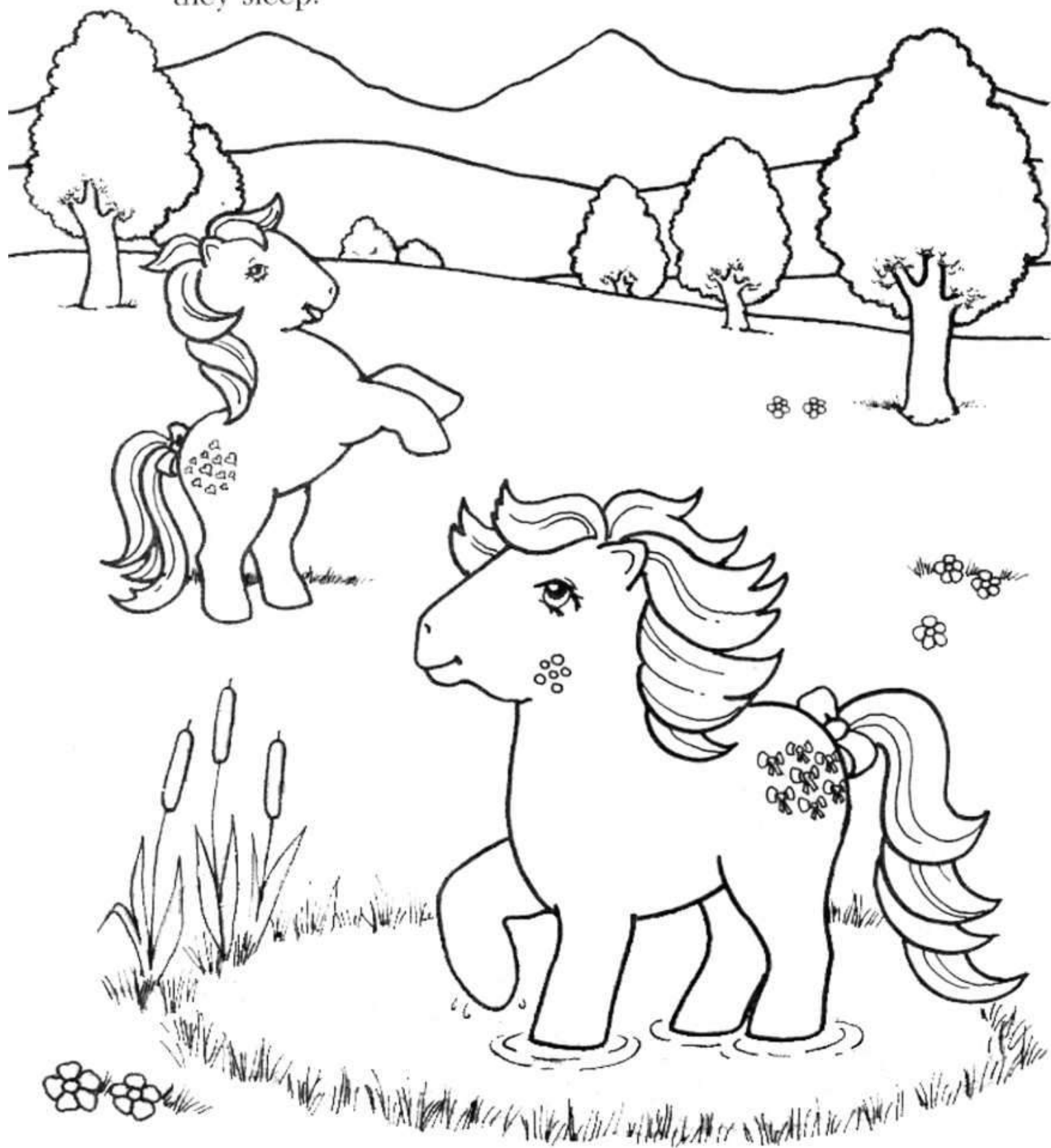

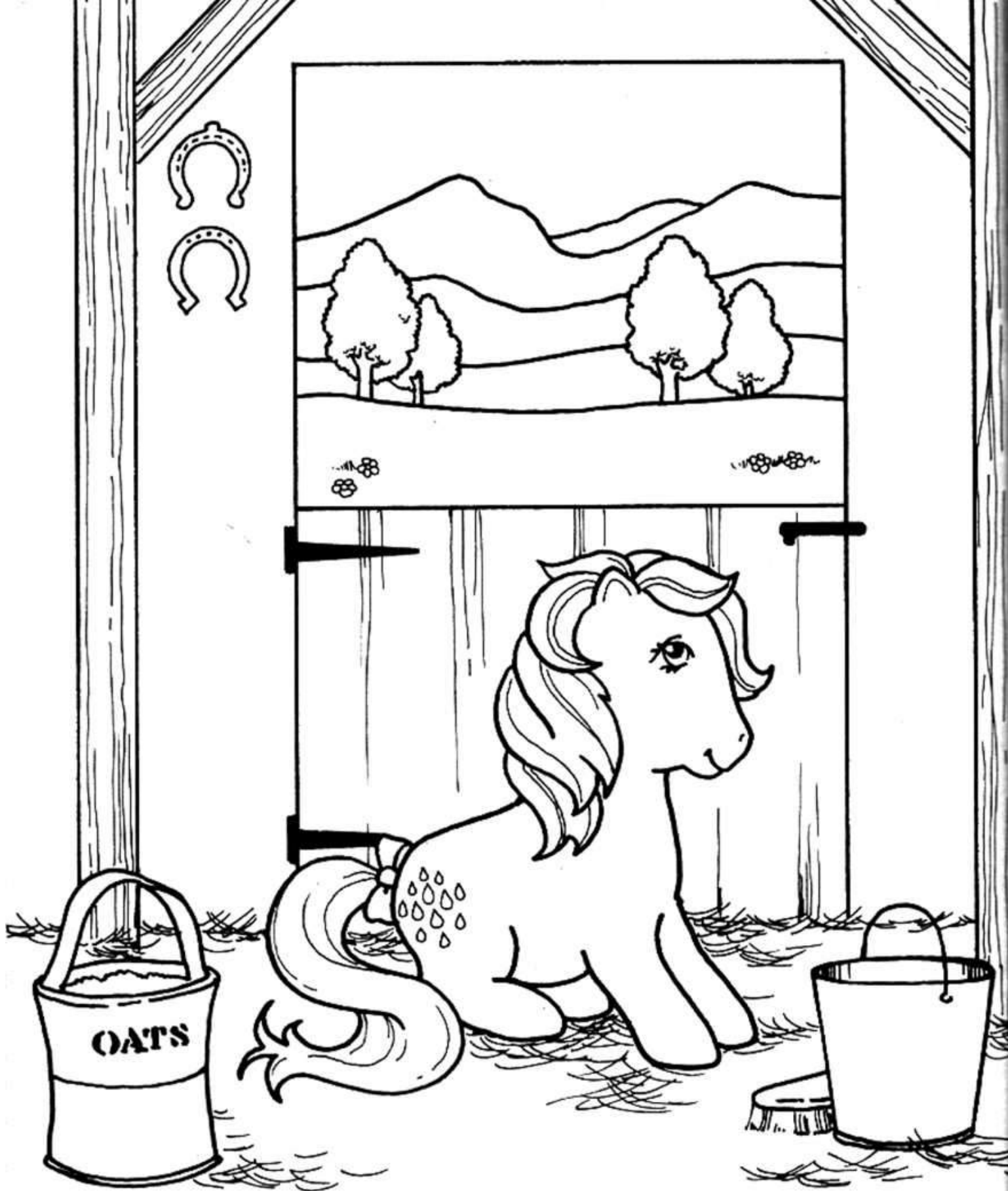


Home at Last
